Arthur Harry Voikos, co-owner along with his wife, of Rob's Bar in downtown Oxford, died January 18, 1992 at St Joseph Mercy Hospital. He was 63.

The couple opened Rob's Bar in 1974 but not until waitresses and barmaids went door to door collecting signatures on petitions to allow hard liquor to be sold within the village limits. At the time only beer and wine were allowed.

The petitions were taken to the village council, which granted the liquor license. Rob's became a fixture at 13 South Washington and expanded to double its size last year.

Mr Voikos lived for the last 20 years in Oxford, where he was a member of the Chamber of Commerce. He was also a member of the Rochester Shrine Club #64 and Masonic Lodge 568.
