No more than one tract or parcel is to be valued or taxed on the same line. Two descriptions must not be joined in one valuation or tax unless a parcel of land described in the government survey by lot number must be so assessed. The description of all lands in each village should be carefully written, under the proper heading, designating accurately the addition or subtraction. The assessment roll should be in harmony.

If the name of the owner of non-resident land is not known it should be assessed as "Owner Unknown."  
 Enter the amount of any Reassessment with red ink, in the column of taxes to which it belongs, above the tax for the year for which this roll is used. The valuation of Personal Property must be made in a different column and the taxes thereon entered on a different line from the Real Property. The name of each special tax must be entered at the head of the column in which it is placed.

The attention of assessing officers is especially called to Sections 1 to 8, 9 (as amended by Act 25 of 1935), 10, 11 (as amended by Act 229 of 1895), amended by Act 262 of 1899, 25 to 40, 41 (as amended by Act 262 of 1899), 42 (as amended by Act 251 of 1897), and 43 of the Tax Law of 1895, therein contained should be strictly followed. See also Sections 91, 93, 102, 103, 107, 118, and 119 of the General Tax Law.
