

Assessment Roll for the Township of Independence

in the County of Oakland for the Year 1884.

No more than one tract or parcel must be valued or taxed on the same line. Two descriptions must not be joined in one valuation or tax, unless owned and occupied as one parcel with section one and if the name of the owner is not known, they should be assessed as "owner unknown."

Personal Estate must be valued and taxes entered on a different line, as well as column, from Real Estate. Non-resident lands should be entered in numerical order, beginning with the tax to which it belongs, above the tax for the year for which this roll is used, and in the column for "Remarks" state opposite each parcel for what year the re-assessment was made.
